WHEREAS, G.S. 160A-267 allows the City to dispose of property by private sale at a negotiated price after Council's approval and advertisement.

WHEREAS, the Hickory Fire Department declares surplus a 26 piece Rescue 42 Strut Kit. The Hickory Fire Department wishes to sell said equipment to Bandys Crossroads Volunteer Fire Department at a negotiated price.

WHEREAS, the Hickory Fire Department declares surplus one Hurst Hydraulic Power Unit, one Combination Spreader/Cutter, one Telescopic Ram, and two Hydraulic Hoses. The Hickory Fire Department wishes to sell said equipment to Sugar Loaf Fire Department at a negotiated price.

WHEREAS, the Hickory Fire Department declares surplus a 44 piece Rescue 42 Strut Kit. The Hickory Fire Department wishes to sell said equipment to Mountain View Volunteer Fire Department at a negotiated price.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Hickory, at their September 15, 2026, City Council meeting authorized the disposal of the surplus property by negotiated price to Bandys Crossroads Volunteer Fire Department, Sugar Loaf Fire Department, and Mountain View Volunteer Fire Department.
